### **Format**

The Key Step gymnastics programme has been produced to provide a progressive competition structure in basic movement and agility that is suitable for children from Key Stage 1 upwards. The aim is to encourage more children to start with gymnastic skills related to the National Curriculum and British Gymnastics through a co-ordinated approach, providing pathways of development.

With that in mind, the Development Festival will provide the opportunity for Teachers and pupils to learn more about Key Steps such as understanding the language used, interpreting the resources, understanding how movements are judged, learning the skills required. Although there will be the opportunity for pupils to take part in the activities outlined in your Key Step Gymnastic Resource Packs, there will not be any judges.

The table below describes the 4 different categories, these are new for the Kent School Games event in 2018, so please do read carefully.

### **Team Competition Format**

This is **NOT** appropriate for pupils who attend school based extra-curricular clubs or Community Club recreational class programmes for more than 1 hour per week, or who are in **any** type of development squad or discipline specific squad – including Floor and Vault.
