Format

The Key Step gymnastics programme has been produced to provide a progressive competition structure in basic movement and agility that is suitable for children from Key Stage 1 upwards. The aim is to encourage more children to start with gymnastic skills related to the National Curriculum and British Gymnastics through a co-ordinated approach, providing pathways of development.

Key Stage 2	Teams working to the Key Step Level 2 activities	
		Children participating in this team would not be capable of Step 3 routines. They may
		be participating in a school based extra-curricular gymnastics class but do not attend
		any community gymnastics club.
Key Stage 2	Years 5/6	Teams working to the Key Step Level 3 activities
		Children participating at Level 3 may attend a school based extra-curricular gymnastics
& / or a community gymnastics club recreational class working on basic		& / or a community gymnastics club recreational class working on basic fundamental
		skills. It is not suitable for children who participate in gymnastics for several hours a
		week.

^{*}Recreational class – basic class, no more than 1 hour a week

- Teams of 4 from the stated year groups, must include at least one girl and one boy
- All children in the team must attempt all 3 activities
- The three top scores per activity for each team will count towards the team total.
- The Competition will be run in accordance with the English Gymnastics Key Step Programme
- Routines will be judges in accordance with the rules set out in the Key Step resource pack.
- Dress: 'T'-Shirt and Shorts or leotards; Bare feet. Long hair tied back.
- No Jewellery permitted.
- No communication from Team Manager (does not apply to disabled participants)
