Enclosed are the football entry forms for the coming season 2016-17. Please ensure that they are returned to me by Friday 9<sup>th</sup> September.

## This season

The Les Riggs and Consolation Cups will continue in their 20 mins e/w format and be played as knockout matches across the season, with teams that lose their first game in the Les Riggs Cup entering the Consolation Cup. Our very successful 'Super Saturday' will continue to be our main event of the year. Mini-festivals will be spread across different venues around the island. Host schools should have at least 2 pitches available. A reminder that schools are responsible for their own first aid, even when they are on another school site. Despite the recent FA grassroots changes we will still play 7-a-side football this season. Unless indicated otherwise, players can only be from Years 5 and 6.

ESFA (English Schools FA) rules are that any adult who is in charge of a school team and who is not employed by the school MUST be registered with ESFA as an AOTT (Adult Other Than a Teacher). This information is also on the ESFA website in case there is any confusion. We haven't had any parents running school teams for a few years now, mainly for the insurance problems this throws up for schools. If a school doesn't have a member of staff involved and thinks they have a suitable parent then this individual MUST be registered with ESFA and will need to have at least an FA Level 1 qualification, an enhanced FA CRB check, have attended an FA Child Protection Workshop and First Aid Course. This is non-negotiable. AOTT forms are available from ESFA. Please also make sure all adults understand that they are role-models for children in their charge and should always display sporting behaviour, winning and losing gracefully and never questioning any decisions made by referees.
