KENT SCHOOLS TABLE TENNIS TEAM

Boys and Girls team event

Rules and Entry Fees

1. The tournament will run in accordance with the Table Tennis England regulations and the referee's/organisers decision will be final.
2. To enter, individuals within the team event, must be eligible for the appropriate age group and schools must be affiliated to the Kent Schools T.T.A. for 2018-2019 and pay the annual fee (see attached form) £15 per secondary school and £10 per primary school. Cheques to be made payable to, K.S.T.T.A. Schools may then enter both the team and individual tournament for that academic year.
3. The tournament will run in accordance with Table Tennis England regulations and the organisers' decision will be final.
4. A match will consist of 8 sets, games will be the best of 3/5 legs (depending on time), eleven up and change service every two points.
5. Players should bring their own light refreshments, drinks and bats and arrive in their P.E. kit and trainers ready to play. Balls will be provided.
6. Players may be required to umpire matches, if they lose the previous match. Teachers may also be asked to umpire matches or record team scores whilst overseeing the team event matches.
7. Teachers are at all times responsible for the welfare, behaviour and conduct of players/pupils and supporters.
8. An official photographer may be present and photographs/ footage of children may be used in future promotional material/newsletter/websites etc.
9. Ages shall be reckoned after the 31st August 2018 (e.g. a pupil aged 11 on or after 1st September 2018 will be eligible to play the U11 event).
10. Each team to consist of 4 players in the same age group **who must play in order of merit** (see nominated players' list attached). Order of play; 1v2, 2v1, 3v4, 4v3, 1v1, 3v2, 2v3, 4v4. If there are any U19 Girls team entries, a different competition format may be adopted.

TEAM AFFILIATION FEE

£15.00 PER SECONDARY SCHOOL, £10.00 PER PRIMARY SCHOOL –

This annual affiliation (payable to K.S.T.T.A.) allows schools and individuals to play in the K.S.T.T.A. Team Event on Wednesday 14th November 2018 (at Medway Park) and the K.S.T.T.A. Individual Tournament on Tues. 11th December 2018 for U13, U16 and U19 Boys singles and Tues. 29th January 2019 for U11 Boys and U11 Girls singles and U13, U16 and U19 Girls singles) (at the Howard School Table Tennis Centre), plus a small individual player entry fee (£6.00 per player).
