Team Information:

- Teams can be between 7-10 players
- Teams are GIRLS only
- All players should be dressed in their school football kit, PE kit, or appropriate clothing for the activity.
- The event will be inclusive of all playing ability

Event Format:

- Teams should arrive at 1300 to register for a 1315 start. Please do not arrive any earlier as the venue will not be ready.
- There will be a carousel of personal challenges and mini games as well as matches.
- The event will be supported by a local secondary school who will be providing Sports Leaders. They will be organising various football activities and refereeing games.
- All activities are planned to be outdoors. In the event of bad weather, we will unfortunately need to postpone or cancel.

General Health and Safety Information

Risk Assessment

This will be completed by the competition lead on the day of the competition, and they will hold a copy of this.

Fire / Emergency

In the case of emergency / evacuation please make your way to the agreed assembly point. Please take your register and let the competition lead know that everyone is present.

Photographs

Sadly we do have to be very careful now of who takes photos, so please if anyone accompanying your team want to take photos they must complete a photo consent form (available on the day) and hand it in at the start of the competition, otherwise photographs will not be permitted.

First Aid/Safeguarding

This is the responsibility of each school and therefore team manager.

Please ensure that the team manager accompanying the team are fully aware of any medical conditions, and if appropriate please make the competition lead aware too.

Each team manager should have with them a charged mobile phone, and emergency contact numbers, as well as a first aid kit for use should they need it.

Health and Safety

Please ensure that ALL children come dressed appropriately for the competition. Any long hair should be tied back and jewellery removed or covered up. We ask that children do not eat in the playing area, and if they want to drink that it is water only, no fizzy drinks.

Each team will need to register at the registration desk as soon as they arrive on site, identifying the number of girls and boys, and adults accompanying the team. We will use this list to cross-reference in the event of an emergency, but please also ensure you have your own registers.
